I am strongly opposed to Section 5 of this bill which seeks to reduce the number of Reducing the Limit on Voter Registration Card Requests. This is a solution in search of a problem, I would challenge the drafters to provide factual evidence that registering too many people to vote is a problem. Execution of Section 5 would create:
