## TESTIMONY ON HOUSE BILL 4086 BEFORE THE HOUSE COMMITTEE ON EARLY CHILDHOOD AND HUMAN SERVICES FEBRUARY 12, 2024

Chair Reynolds, Vice-Chairs Nguyen and Scharf, and Members of the Committee:

My name is Jordan Bates, Senior Assistant General Counsel at the Oregon Judicial Department (OJD). While OJD is neutral on HB 4086 with the -1 amendment, we appreciate the inclusion of a Chief Justice appointment to each task force and focus our testimony on those sections.

HB 4086 with the -1 amendment directs the Oregon Department of Human Services (ODHS) to commission two studies: one focusing on the scope of child abuse investigations in Oregon; and the other focusing on Oregon's response to children exhibiting problematic sexual behavior. Both include specified findings and reporting requirements. Each study will be led by a facilitator in collaboration with an advisory committee, which includes appointments by ODHS and the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court. The Chief Justice's appointments to each committee include a judge who hears dependency cases. OJD welcomes the opportunity to work collaboratively with stakeholders to provide the court's input and perspectives on these important topics.
