

## Testimony in support of SB 1594-1 Improving safety of behavioral health workers

On behalf of the Association of Oregon Community Mental Health Programs (AOCMHP), representing CMHPs statewide who manage and provide behavioral health services for their communities, I would like to express our support for SB 1594-1 to establish a task force on improving safety of behavioral health workers and for the investment in grants to help behavioral health agencies improve workforce safety.

Public behavioral health system work is difficult, and we must protect our valuable workforce through safety protocols, appropriate staffing levels, and training, all of which will require additional funding.
