I support the bill's key solutions:

Incentives: Creates an Opportunity Fund within Business Oregon to support companies in establishing, retooling, or expanding clean energy technology manufacturing facilities in Oregon. A down payment of \$20M will increase Oregon's competitiveness in securing roughly 40x that in federal incentives.

Procurement: Directs the Department of Administrative Services (DAS) to develop a statewide policy for evaluating and procuring zero-emission technologies to promote in-state clean tech job creation and manufacturing.

Task Force: Establishes a statewide advisory council to support public-private partnership and identify additional strategic policy mechanisms and tools for Oregon to attract, grow and sustain clean energy technology companies.
