SDAO has approximately 950 members representing about 32 different types of districts including parks and recreation, library, water, sewer, irrigation, ports, and soil and water conservation districts to name a few. SDAO would like to express its support for the dash three (-3) amendment to SB 1576, which would temporarily provide a "fix" to the Fields v Newport case.
