I think the most important element of SB is:

SECTION 2. ORS 337.120 is amended to read: 337.120. (1)(a) A district school board, with the assistance of teachers and administrators

(B) To comply with the prohibition on discrimination required by ORS 659.850, may not prohibit the use of, or refuse to approve the use of, textbooks and instructional materials on the basis that the textbooks or instructional materials include a study of the roles and contributions of any individual or group against whom discrimination is prohibited under ORS 659.850.
