There is currently one nonprofit in Portland that runs an interpretation agency. Unfortunately, among

the agencies that I work with, they pay the least. We are constantly told that it is because they are a

nonprofit. So, how will this new nonprofit increase our pay?

I personally like having choices between the companies that I work with. If the nonprofit is created, I

would like to ensure that hospitals are not forced to work with them. If they can be competitive in

pricing for interpreters in a private market, then I will consider working with them.

Lastly, Senator Bonham asked during the hearing what will wages continue to look like if this bill is not

passed. The answer stated \$18-\$25. That is certainly not my experience. The companies that I work with

on a regular basis compensate me at \$37-\$42 per hour. I negotiated these rates. I also receive travel

bonuses, and mileage is compensated if I drive over a certain amount to get to an assignment.
