Measure: HB4090

I support the -6 amendment to HB 4090 submitted by Representative Mark Gamba. Nuclear needs to be omitted from HB 4090 to preserve the will of the voters. Oregon's 1980 Ballot Measure Law, (ORS 469.590, 469.593, 469.595, 469.597, 469.599 and 469.601) was passed by voters in 1980 prohibiting the construction of nuclear power plants in Oregon.

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

-6 The amendment excludes nuclear power plants from electric power generating plants affected by the measure and requires the person seeking federal approval to construct or operate an energy facility affected by the measure to consult with the applicable local government, or local governments adjacent to the proposed facility on potential impacts.
