I OPPOSE [HB 4028-2].

There is a finite amount of Federal dollars.

There exists a material flaw in [HB 4028-2] which makes 340B programs more expensive.

Congress has not amended the 340B Drug Pricing Program to act as a "Universal Health Care" provider.

340B has been used to fund Healthcare Costs to individuals and Non-Profit Corporations who rely on the Federal Funds and are not recognized as contracted-covered entities.

340B Drug Pricing Program has strict obligations imposed on regulated entities which in turns effects the Pharmaceutical Pricing Agreements (PPAs) and Rebate Percentage calculations.

340B Drug Pricing Programs are growing faster than intended.

[HB 4028-2] negates the "strict federally imposed regulations."

Drug Manufacturers are under "No Obligation" to offer discounted drugs to every pharmacy-only contract-covered entities.

President Biden's intentional facilitation and enabling Illegal Immigration will compound an already compromised 340B program.

If [HB 4028-2] is Enrolled, Drug Manufacturers might give the "middle-finger" to the State of Oregon.

The Federal Courts appear to have already ruled in the Drug Manufacturers favor.
