Simply put, non physician owned staffing model leads to unsafe working conditions. The physicians are simply tasked with seeing too many patients. This generates more revenue for the owners — who don't feel the pain of being understaffed. There is a safe and effective staffing model based on 'patients per hour'. Physician run practices invariably get to a happy medium of income generated and enjoyable shifts. This keeps burnout/turnover low and allows for excellent medical care. In certain area, there are no other options we we end up working in unsafe, unpleasant departments — solely to generate more revenue for the owners of the group. If unchecked, it will lead to a death spiral of emergency medicine.
