[HB 5203] Text states,

"...A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to state financial administration; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1.

There is appropriated to _____, for the biennium ending June 30, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$_____ for _____.

SECTION 2.

Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$_____ is established for the biennium ending June 30, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses for _____ from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the _____.

SECTION 3.

Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$_____ is established for the biennium ending June 30, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses for _____ from federal funds collected or received by the _____. ..."
