

SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

HB 4081

Relating to emergency medical services

HB 4081 modernizes Oregon’s emergency medical services system by establishing a program and advisory board, supported by the advice and technical expertise of advisory committees, to support regional advisory boards responsible for the development and oversight of regional EMS plans. It also directs the new EMS program to establish and maintain an EMS data system.

The fiscal impact of the measure is indeterminate. The board and committees will determine the extent of support required by the Oregon Health Authority’s staff and assess the need for additional contracts to support their work.

The Human Services Subcommittee recommends HB 4081 be reported out do pass.
