Adoption of Housing Production Strategies and Housing Capacity Analyses

A statewide methodologdirecting implementation of gent and bold actions estimating regional housing needs statewide planning goals equitable housing outcomes in local housing production and further Fair housing production and targ 10 — Housing and 14 — Urbanization

A partnership between state and local governments to remove barriers to housing production, affordability, and choice

exception and nonresource lands

high-value farmland (ORS 195.300) or high-value forestland

high-value farmland ORS 215.710(1) or high-value forestland

prime and unique soils

- Response to SB 1129 (2025) to allow lower priority in the first category for
 - Residential planned developments/subdivisions, and
 - Where urban services are not reasonable or cost-effective

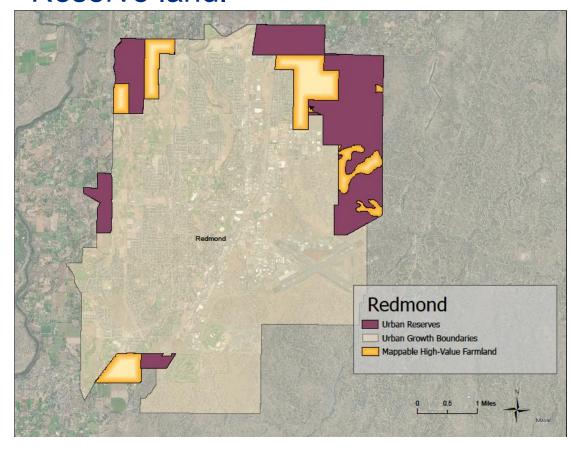
