

Stakeholder Participation:

Major Falcon Group Findings



- Antiquated facilities.
- Aging and higher acuity AIC population.
- Out of facility health care appointments.
- A reliance on paper health records.
- Staffing challenges.
- Modernized IT systems.
- A Continuous Quality Improvement (CQI) program.

Implementation Plan



The most immediate needs are being implemented first:

1. Clearing the backlog of appointments with specialty care providers.
2. Implementing the Electronic Health Records (EHR) system.
3. Developing a Continuous Quality Improvement (CQI) program.
4. Changing Health Services organizational structure.

Next steps:

1. Oregon State Penitentiary EHR launch (November).
2. Implementation Plan roll-out (December 9th, 2025).
