

SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

Item 8: Department of Emergency Management Security Enhancements for Nonprofits

The Public Safety Subcommittee heard a request from the Department of Emergency Management for retroactive approval to submit a federal grant application to the U.S. Department of Homeland Security for the Nonprofit Security Grant Program.

The Department has received this grant in prior years and utilizes funds for two programs: the state program portion is a formula grant for nonprofits statewide to prevent and respond to acts of terrorism, and the Urban Area Security Initiative portion is a competitive grant that is specific to assisting high-threat, high-density urban area efforts in the Portland Metro Region.

The Department has applied for \$3.4 million in grant funding and there is no match requirement. If awarded, the Department will work with the Oregon Department of Justice to confirm it can meet the federal terms and conditions prior to accepting any funds.

The Public Safety Subcommittee recommends that the Joint Interim Committee on Ways and Means retroactively approve the submission of a federal grant application by the Department of Emergency Management to the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, in the amount of \$3.4 million, to support nonprofits' efforts to prevent and respond to acts of terrorism.
