Dear Senator Lieber and Representative Sanchez:

The Legislative Assembly budget includes salaries, services and supplies and per diem for legislative members and their staff, the leadership and caucus offices, the Secretary of the Senate, the Chief Clerk of the House, session staff. The Legislative Assembly budget also includes funding for the Legislative Equity Office, however, for purposes of reviewing reduction options, the Legislative Equity Office has submitted separate documentation.

Absent the Legislative Equity Office, the Legislative Assembly's 2025-27 adopted budget totals \$80.1 million General Fund. Statute requires legislative and judicial branch agencies to retain any remaining General Fund balances, typically referred to as reversions, from the previous biennium for the payment of expenses for the next biennium. To mitigate the impact of General Fund reductions on core services and positions, legislative branch agencies have prioritized utilizing these anticipated reversions from the 2023-25 biennium to help achieve the reduction targets. Finally, no programs or additional functions have been established or expanded within the Legislative Assembly since the 2021-23 biennium.
