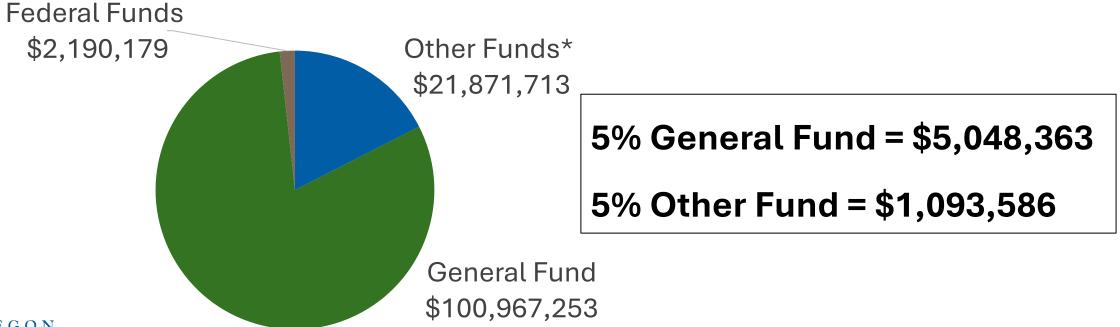

#### **Process and Criteria**

- Top priority is serving Oregonians
- To provide services, must preserve positions
- Assumed actions are one-time
- Weighed short and long-term impacts of one-time reduction
- Ability to make progress on existing projects and sustain operational functions



## **General Themes - First 2.5% General Fund**

Travel, career development and training opportunities, field equipment and supplies, office expenditures	\$495k
Grant programs: feasibility studies and water use measurement	\$593k
Facilitation for complex water issues	\$880k
Surface and groundwater data collection and analysis	\$200k
Direct appropriations for water projects	\$325k

### **General Themes - Second 2.5% General Fund**

Direct appropriations for water projects	\$825k
Public information, outreach and public engagement, and facilitation for complex water issues	\$479k
Surface and groundwater data collection and analysis	\$1.2m
Shift dam safety staff to federal funds	\$70k



### **General Themes – 5% Other Fund**

Travel, career development and training opportunities, field \$257k equipment and supplies, office expenditures

Staffing field, well construction oversite, hydroelectric project licensing, and groundwater science
