# Oregon Public Defense Commission

**Reduction Options** 

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#### Selection Criteria

**Guiding Principle**: Prioritization of Core Responsibilities and the maintenance of programmatic integrity.

- Protect constitutionally-mandated public defense services to indigent clients;
- Limit impacts to agency positions working to ensure the timely delivery of defense services; and
- Prioritize the continuation of reductions in the unrepresented-persons crisis.

Reduction options do not reflect agency value judgments as to program effectiveness or quality.



# **Agency Process**

#### Identifying and Ranking Reductions.

- Non-constitutionally and non-statutory mandated items were ranked first (e.g., discovery reimbursement, internal agency reductions).
- Other reductions were ranked according to potential impact.

#### Stakeholder Engagement.

- The Agency Director had a high-level discussion with Commission members at OPDC's October Commission Meeting.
- Stakeholders, including representatives of providers, were consulted after reduction lists were posted on OLIS.



### **Impacts**

Reductions carry potential risks to service delivery or the system as a whole.



# Minimizing Potential Impacts

Some budget reduction options would have minimal impacts on service delivery (either to indigent clients and/or service providers).

- Savings in rent by shifting OPDC trial team staff to local courthouses in the Portland metro area.
- Reductions in training, services, and supplies, holding positions vacant.

The majority of reductions, however, risk impacting the provision of public defense services or carry the risk of merely shifting costs.
