


Voter Registration Requirements

Voters can register ***online, by paper, or through automatic voter registration.***

They must meet the following requirements:


- ✓ Voter attestation of U.S. Citizenship.
- ✓ Voter must have established Oregon residency.
- ✓ Voter must provide valid proof of identification or last four digits of a SSN.
- ✓ Voter must provide a valid signature.



Robust Vote-by-Mail Processes




Ballots are

& tabulated




Ballots are stored

- ✓ Many counties offer **livestream** and **step-by-step explanations**.




Vote-by-Mail and USPS

The United States Postal Service is a **critical partner**.


Recent changes impacting **transit** and **postmarking**.

Our goal is to preserve the **accessibility** and **trust** of the current system, while strengthening **resilience**.




