

# Campaign Finance Law: *Before HB 4024*

- Before HB 4024—and still today—Oregon operates a continuous reporting system.
- Prior to HB 4024, Oregon did not have limits on contributions or spending.
- Oregon will now join a minority of states that do the following:
  - Proactively enforces campaign finance limits.
  - Regulates contributions across connected networks of donors and committees.
  - Imposes penalties on individual contributors.




