The Governor has appointed the following individual to the Commission for the Blind subject to Senate confirmation.¹

Composition³

The commission consists of seven members:

- four blind individuals (BROOME, GOODMAN, McGARY, PORTER); and
- three individuals from among:
 - employers (HUDSON);
 - labor;
 - optometry (LABRUM);
 - ophthalmology; and
 - o education of persons who are blind (WALL).

Only one appointee may represent the same area during the same term. Appointments should be made from the five areas on a rotating basis. Members serve four-year terms and are removed from office if absent from three consecutive meetings or more than one-third of the scheduled meetings in one year.

Duties⁴

The commission serves the needs of Oregon's citizens who experience vision loss and need specialized training and support to lead full and productive lives. Its duties include

- establishing and administering programs for the welfare of persons with visual impairments, including cooperation by contract or otherwise with public and private agencies in providing services, programs, and facilities for persons with visual impairments;
- responsibility for the fiscal oversight, including development of the commission's budget, review of financial statements, and directing resources to implement program goals;
- employing an administrator;
- maintaining a confidential register of persons who are blind, describing the extent of blindness, and other information;
- administering programs for the conservation and restoration of sight and the prevention of blindness, and for vocational rehabilitation;
- cooperating with Department of Human Services to administer programs;
- overseeing the administration of vending facilities in public buildings or on public property; and
- ensuring the active participation of the commission's business enterprise consumer committee in major administrative, policy, and program development decisions that impact the commission's business enterprise program.
