SUBJECT: November 18 Reproductive Health Questions

Dear Co-Chairs and Committee Members:

Please find below information requested by members of the Joint Emergency Board Committee at the November 18 meeting on Oregon Health Authority's reproductive health funding request. The following information provides an overview of the geographic distribution of providers in the state that provide the same or substantially similar services as Planned Parenthood. Additionally, it provides an overview of the primary care workforce capacity in Oregon.

Planned Parenthood of the Columbia Willamette (PPCW) and Planned Parenthood of Southwestern Oregon (PPSO) operate eleven (11) health centers in Oregon and one (1) in Vancouver, Washington. PPCW has one clinic in Clackamas, Clark (WA), Deschutes, Malheur, Marion, and Washington counties and two clinics in Multnomah County. PPSO has one clinic in Jackson County and two clinics in Lane County.

Both PP affiliates provide comprehensive reproductive health care, including sexually transmitted infection testing and treatment, contraception, cancer screening and prevention, pregnancy tests and counseling, and abortion care. PPCW and PPSO are both Oregon Health Authority (OHA) Reproductive Health (RH) Program-certified clinics. As part of this network, PPCW and PPSO are required to adhere to a robust set of standards that outline the provision of high quality, culturally responsive reproductive health services to all clients regardless of ability to pay. Examples of RH Program certification requirements include: dispensing all medications and contraceptive methods on site, providing up to a full year's worth of contraception, adopting clinical practice standards for the full scope of services as defined by the RH Program, and providing a

In addition to PPCW and PPSO, the RH Program's network of certified clinics includes 53 agencies operating 110 clinics across the state (see attached for complete list of certified agencies and clinics). These agencies are held to the same certification standards as the PPs and are required to offer the same scope of services, with the exception of abortion care. They include local public health authorities (LPHAs), federally qualified health centers (FQHCs), school-based health centers (SBHCs), University health centers, and other community-based clinics. Adherence to RH Program-certification requirements set participating clinics apart as essential and different from other providers of reproductive health care.

Existing access to these clinics is variable across the state and would be further compromised if the PPs were unable to continue to provide care. For example, PPCW operates the only RH Program-certified clinics in Deschutes and Marion counties and is only one of two certified clinics in Malheur County (the other being Malheur County Health Department). Many LPHAs located in rural or frontier counties have limited clinical staff capacity and may only see clients a few days per week. Many FQHCs, whether certified with the RH Program or not, have also reported lengthy waiting lists for new clients, often resulting in delays in timely access to care. In calendar year 2024, PPCW and PPSO served 68% of OHP members who accessed family planning and reproductive health services at RH Program-certified clinics. If access were no longer available at the PPs, the RH Program's network of other certified clinics would be unable to absorb their clients. While non-RH Program-certified clinics may have some capacity to serve clients previously seen at PP clinics, they would be unlikely to provide the same scope and level of care (e.g., dispensing a full year's worth of contraception onsite).

Primary Care Workforce Supply in Oregon


[OHA's Health Care Workforce Reporting Program \(HWRP\)](#) partners with licensing boards to collect these data during the license renewal process to inform policy decision making and educational investments.

Primary care professionals include physicians and physician assistants who specialize in family practice, general practice, geriatric medicine, pediatrics, adolescent medicine, internal medicine or obstetrics and gynecology; nurse practitioners who specialize in family practice, geriatrics, pediatrics, internal medicine or obstetrics/gynecology/women's health; and naturopathic physicians who specialize in family medicine, pediatrics, geriatrics or obstetrics.

The county provider-to-population ratio (the number of providers compared to the number of individuals within a given county) helps us understand how well the supply of

health care professionals can meet health care needs within a given area. This map below uses direct patient care full-time equivalents (FTE) to calculate provider-to-patient ratios.

Statewide, in 2024 there were an estimated 17.0 primary care professionals per 10,000 people in Oregon, although this provider-to-population ratio differs depending on county. County provider-to-population ratios for primary care providers range from 4.6 per 10,000 in Sherman County to 34.6 per 10,000 in Wallowa County while some counties fall closer to the statewide average, like Union County at 17.0 per 10,000.

- These ratios are based on physical practice locations where providers deliver care and do not reflect telehealth practices.
- The ratio reported here for Baker County, 25.0, may be slightly inflated due to data interpretation issues.
