


PROGRESS MADE ON 5-YEAR PLAN

PROGRESS ON THE 5-YEAR PLAN TO ADDRESS THE UNCLASSIFIED REGISTRANT POPULATION

- As of October 6, the Board successfully completed the hiring and onboarding process for all 9 new limited duration positions funded by HB 5027.
- A comprehensive training program is currently on track and should be completed in March 2026.
- As presented in the original 5-year funding plan, the Board amended its rules to authorize the use of a Targeted Assessment for a specific population of historic registrants.
- The Board expects to make measurable progress on classifying the historic population in the coming months.

STATUS & UPDATED DATA

STATUS OF THE BACKLOG AND UPDATED DATA

- Since the 2025 legislative session, there have been significant data refinements by the Oregon State Police on the status of the backlog. Accordingly, previously reported backlog numbers have been revised following efforts by the Oregon State Police to update their database and refine their search criteria. The exact number of historic registrants currently under the Board's authority to classify stands at 8,888 as of January 5, 2026, down from the 11,091 as reported in 2025. This number provides a clearer, more accurate scope of the work remaining.



5-YEAR PROJECTED TARGET DATE


TIMELINE FOR COMPLETION

- The Board is currently on track to meet the June 30, 2030, target as outlined in the 5-year plan submitted to the legislature in the 2025 legislative session.
- By June 30, 2030, all registrants currently living, working, or attending school in Oregon, and who are under the Board's authority to classify, will be classified and placed into an appropriate notification level.
- The Board's ability to meet the target date is contingent on continued funding as provided in the 5-year plan.



5-YEAR TARGET BENCHMARKS- CHART


