LC 100: Requires health insurance carriers offering group or individual plans in Oregon to fully cover medically necessary cervical cancer screenings and follow-up examinations without deductibles, coinsurance, copayments, or other out-of-pocket expenses. Includes initial screening tests to detect cervical cancer or precancerous lesions, plus follow-up examinations when abnormalities are detected, such as human papillomavirus testing with typing, cytology, dual stain, or colposcopy with biopsy. Exempts health savings account-qualified plans. (Dated 12/16/2025)

LC 101: Directs the Oregon Health Authority to study health care. (Dated 12/3/2025)

LC 102: Directs the Oregon Health Authority to study health care. (Dated 12/3/2025)
