**1. LC 155 (dated 12/02/2025): Relating to worker protections**

**Summary:** Requires the Bureau of Labor and Industries to study issues relating to worker protections. Directs the bureau to submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to labor and business no later than September 15, 2027. Sunsets on January 2, 2028.

**2. LC 178 (dated 01/09/2026): Relating to total disability**

**Summary:** Provides that the percentage of a worker's wage paid as compensation during a period of temporary total disability shall be determined by the portion of the worker's age that is less than or equal to, or greater than, 75 percent of the state average weekly wage.

**3. LC 220 (dated 01/09/2026): Relating to the administration of moneys within the Paid Family and Medical Leave Insurance Fund**

**Summary:** Authorizes the Director of the Employment Department to adopt rules establishing an accounting system for handling moneys in the Paid Family and Medical Leave Insurance Fund. Takes effect on the 91<sup>st</sup> day following adjournment sine die.
