LC 38

Relating to: Home and Community-Based Services Workforce Standards Board

Dated: December 23, 2025

Summary: Establishes the Home and Community-Based Services Workforce Standards Board, directed to establish minimum working standards for the home and community-based services workforce. Requires the board to report to the Legislative Assembly and to the Governor the increase in funding needed to implement the standard. Permits the Bureau of Labor and Industries to make determinations regarding implementation and compliance. Requires the board to conduct a quadrennial comprehensive review and to submit a biennial report to the Governor and the Legislative Assembly. Requires the online registry administered by the Department of Human Services to include workers from the home and community-based workforce.

LC 103

Relating to: Elections

Dated: December 3, 2025

Summary: Requires the Secretary of State to study elections. Directs the Secretary of State to submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to elections not later than September 15, 2027. Sunsets on January 2, 2028.

LC 104

Relating to: Electors of President and Vice President of the United States

Dated: January 7, 2026

Summary: Establishes the qualifications of an elector of President and Vice President of the United States. Provides the contents of a certificate of ascertainment of electors. Provides that an elector who does not vote in accordance with the signed pledge of electors vacates the office of elector. Provides for the filling of the vacancy. Provides for mileage expenses to be given to electors who attend the meeting of electors and whose ballot is not invalid. Takes effect on July 1, 2026.
