SUMMARY

Digest: This Act tells BOLI to study the laws that govern labor contractors. (Flesch Readability Score: 67.7).

Requires the Bureau of Labor and Industries to study the adequacy of the statutory provisions governing labor contractors. Directs the bureau to submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to labor and business no later than September 15, 2027.

Sunsets on January 2, 2028.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to labor contractors.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. The Bureau of Labor and Industries shall study the adequacy of the provisions of ORS 658.405 to 658.511 governing labor contractor regulation and shall make recommendations to improve compliance, efficiency and enforcement. The bureau shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to labor and business no later than September 15, 2027.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2026 Act is repealed on January 2, 2028.
