LC 77 is a placeholder measure relating to education. The contents of this measure may be replaced at a later date.

LC 132 includes five changes to Oregon education law:

- It aligns requirements for the Oregon Health and Science University (OHSU) Board of Directors regarding student members and frequency of board meetings with those of the seven public universities.
- It allows education service district (ESD) boards to offer board members a stipend of up to \$500 per month.
- It removes a reference to federal statute from the Military Interstate Children's Compact.
- It grants rulemaking authority to the State Board of Education in areas of statute that incorrectly grant such authority to the Oregon Department of Education.
- It adds a requirement for graduate students employed by OHSU to provide contact information and to sign a consent form authorizing the university to release that contact information as part of their employment record.
