Labor Standards (Agreed Rate, Minimum Wage, Overtime etc.)



1.97 staff per 100,000 workers

1 LNI Employee for every 6,579 Employers



0.905 staff per 100,000 workers

1 BOLI Employee for every 17,391 employers in Oregon

Washington has 118% more staff per capita than Oregon.
