



Law Enforcement Accountability & Visibility Act (LEAVA)

- I. Expand existing masking and officer identification law to include all law enforcement officers operating in the state:
 - Include a non-criminal tool for local/state law enforcement to investigate the identities of people wearing masks where there is reasonable suspicion or probable cause that the individuals are impersonating a law enforcement officer
 - **Require** every agency operating in the state to have a public policy regarding the use of facial coverings that generally prohibits masking
- II. Draw clear lines between state/local and federal operations, and provide for transparency when cooperation occurs:
 - **Prohibit** any Oregon state and local employees, including public universities, from cooperating with federal or another state's crackdowns on free speech or targeting of protected classes
 - Include volunteers in civil defense forces within SPA (and the Tort Claims Act)
- III. Review local/state law enforcement participation in federal joint task forces and cross-deputizations with an out-of-state or federal law enforcement agency or agencies to protect our sanctuary laws:
 - Make the terms of their agreements/Memorandums of Understanding publicly available
 - **Prohibit** state/local agency or officer from engaging in surveillance or investigation based on First Amendment activities or protected classes
 - **Prohibit** the use of confidential informants to conduct investigations of protected free speech and expression or based on membership in a protected class under state civil rights and anti-discrimination law
 - **Prohibit** state/local deputizations from exercising federal law enforcement authority that would cause the state/local officer to be in violation of Oregon law or immunize the state/local officer from violations of state/local law
- IV. Cause of action by anyone impacted by a violation of the above, to seek injunctive relief as well as monetary damages, punitive damages, and attorney's fees.
