Impact - THEN

- 1946- Micky Pease, a Portland Police Officer, recognized the need for a SAFE place where boys could run off some energy and as a result, stay out of trouble.
- 1953- Lents Elementary (SE Portland) becomes our 1st Clubhouse
- 1955- Pal Boys Club of Portland, Inc. affiliated with Boys Clubs of America
- 1981- 1st Youth Partner Lunch held (Youth of the Year Banquet)
- 1985- Name change to Boys & Girls Clubs of Portland Metropolitan Area
- 1993- BGCP buys building for Clubhouse in Hillsboro
- 1996- Blazers Boys & Girls Club (Northeast Portland) opens
