

SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

Item 12: Oregon Military Department Corvallis Armory

The Public Safety Subcommittee heard a request from the Oregon Military Department on the Corvallis Armory service life extension project.

Since 2021, the Oregon Military Department has been in the process of extending the service life of the Corvallis Armory for a total investment of \$9.8 million. The agency requires \$800,000 Federal Funds to complete existing projects by February 2026. The agency can use remaining federal funding from other projects to fund this request, and no state matching funds are required.

The Public Safety Subcommittee recommends that the Joint Interim Committee on Ways and Means recommend including an increase of \$800,000 in Federal Funds capital construction expenditure limitation for the Oregon Military Department in a budget reconciliation bill during the 2026 legislative session for the Corvallis Armory service life extension project.
