Moves materials between collection vehicles for transport to a final disposal location

Material Recovery, Commingled Recycling Processing, Limited Sort

Separates materials for recycling

Commercial Composting

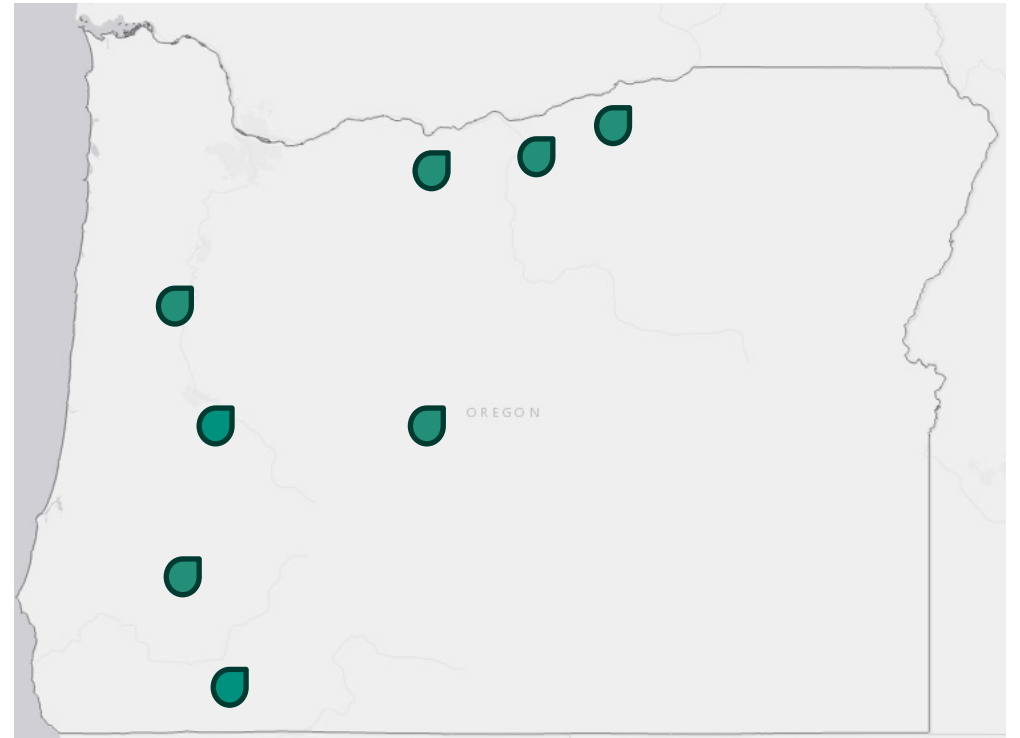
Produces a useful product through a managed biological decomposition



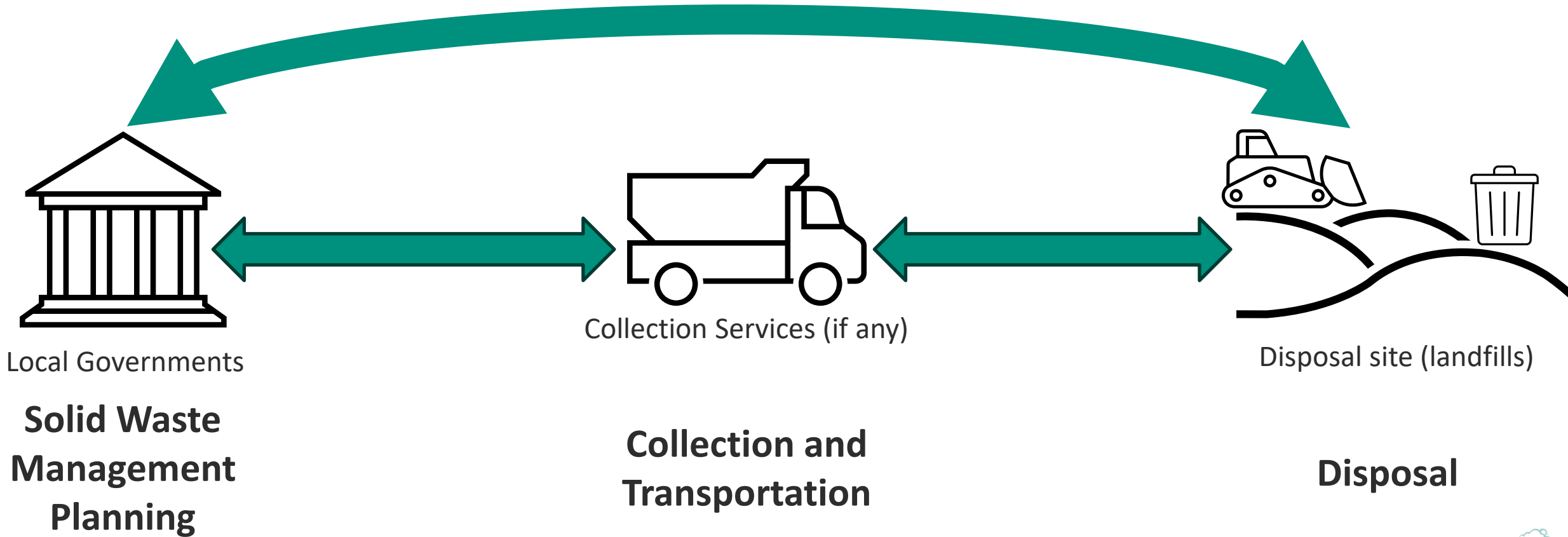
Solid Waste Facilities

- Industrial or special waste landfills



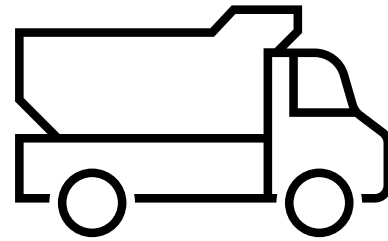

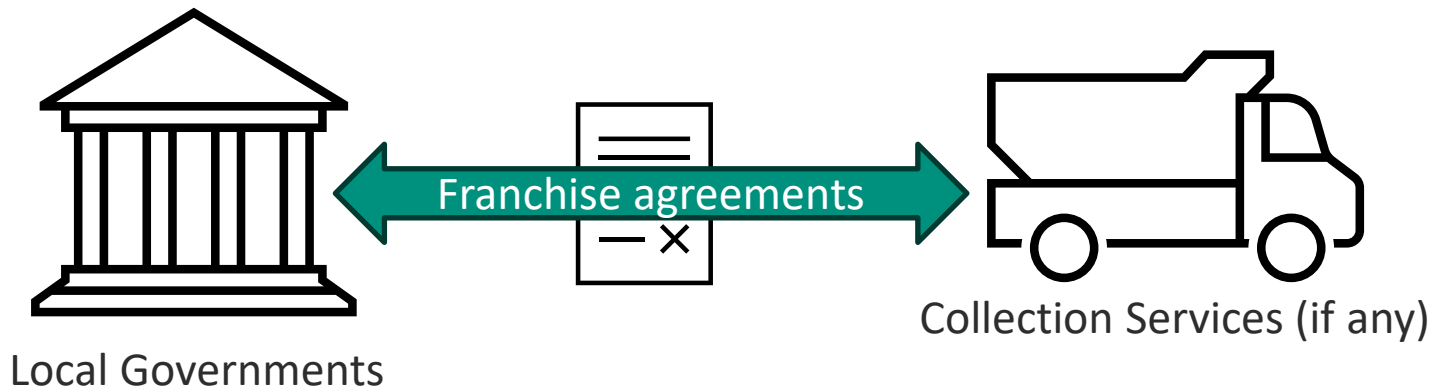
