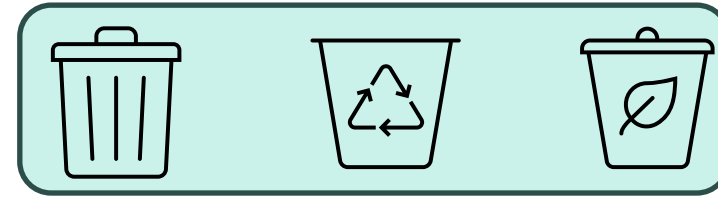

What is "Solid Waste"?

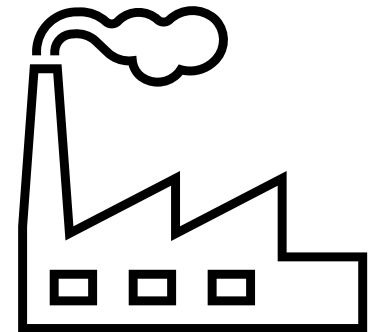
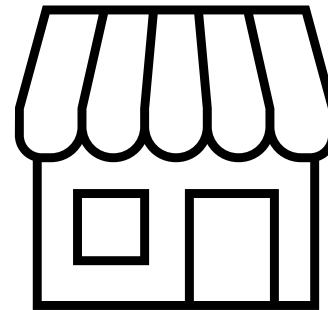
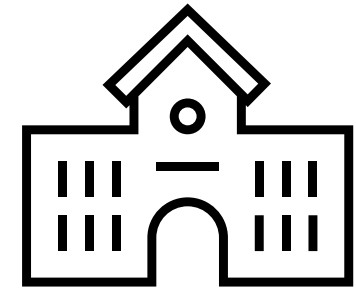
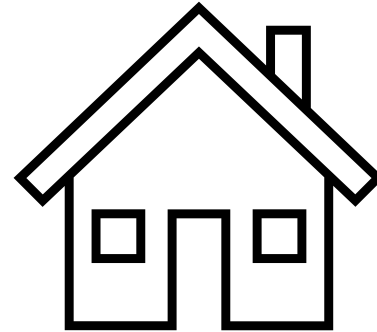
"Solid Waste" means all discarded materials.

- Institutions



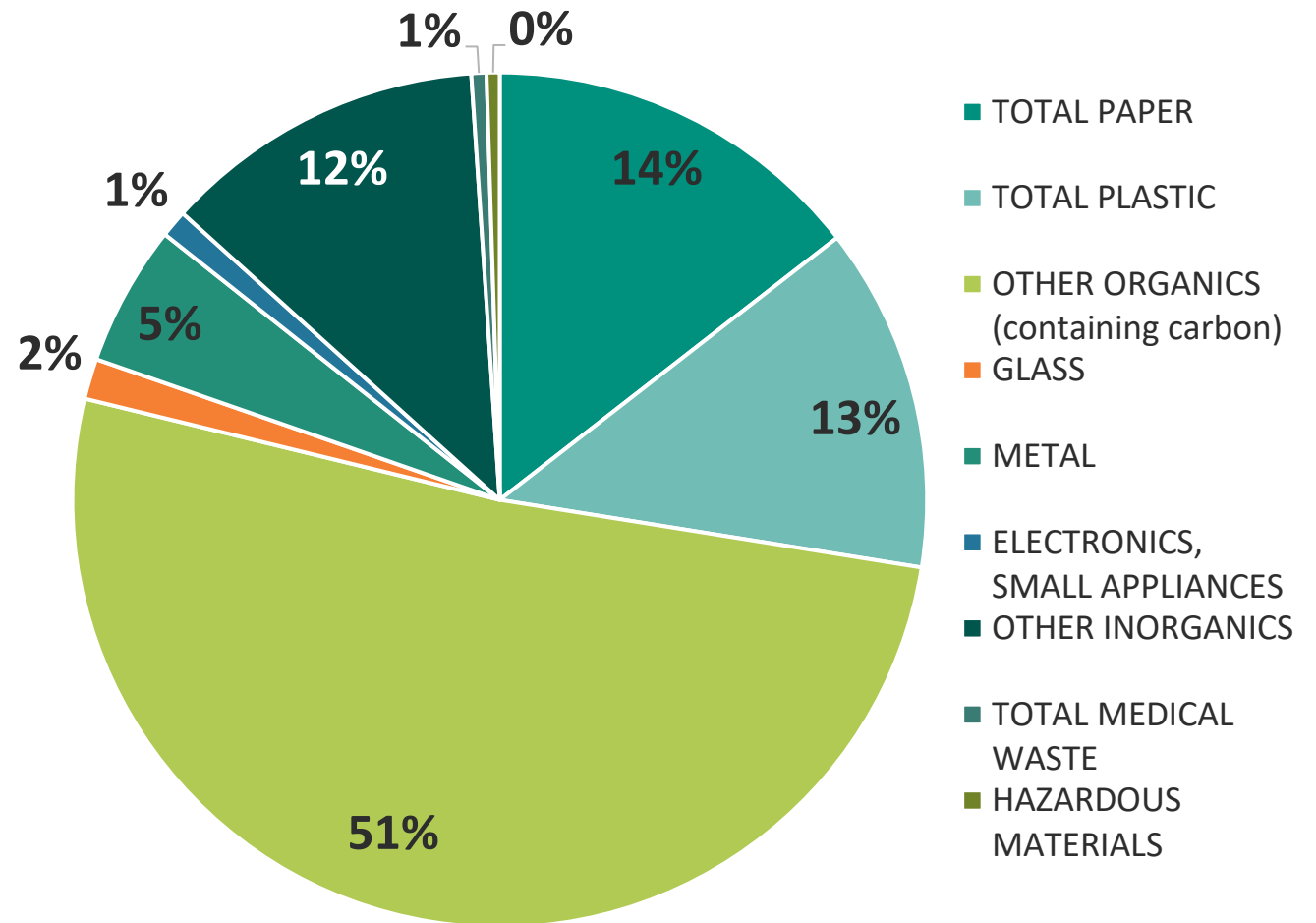
Solid Waste Management Framework

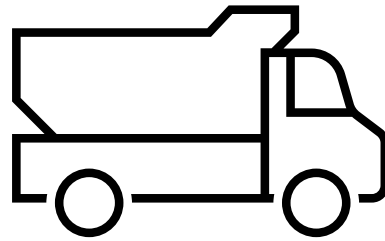

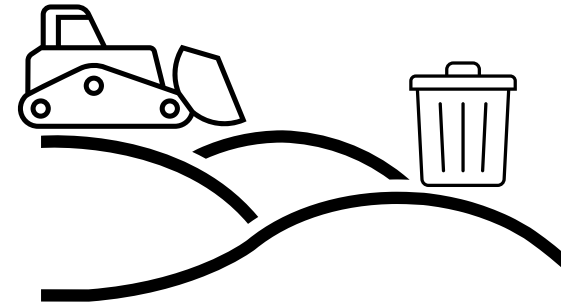
