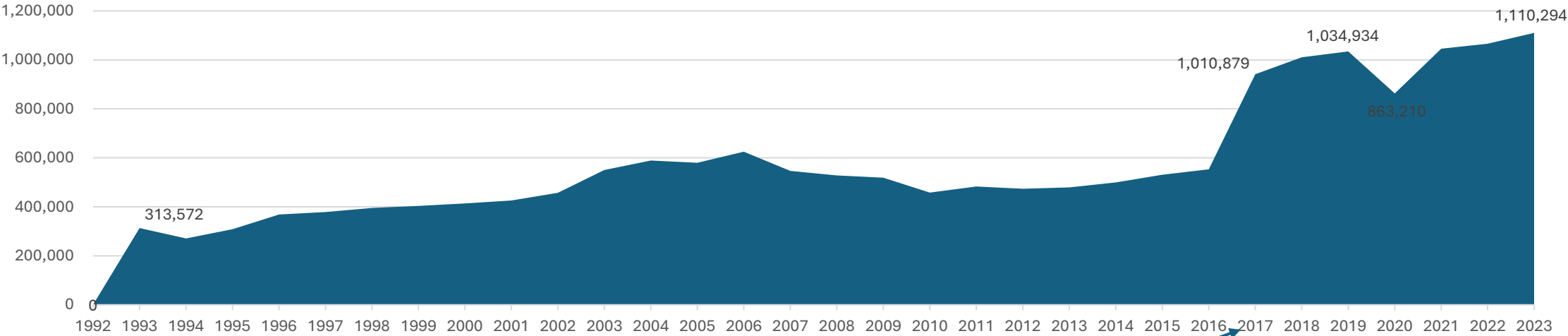

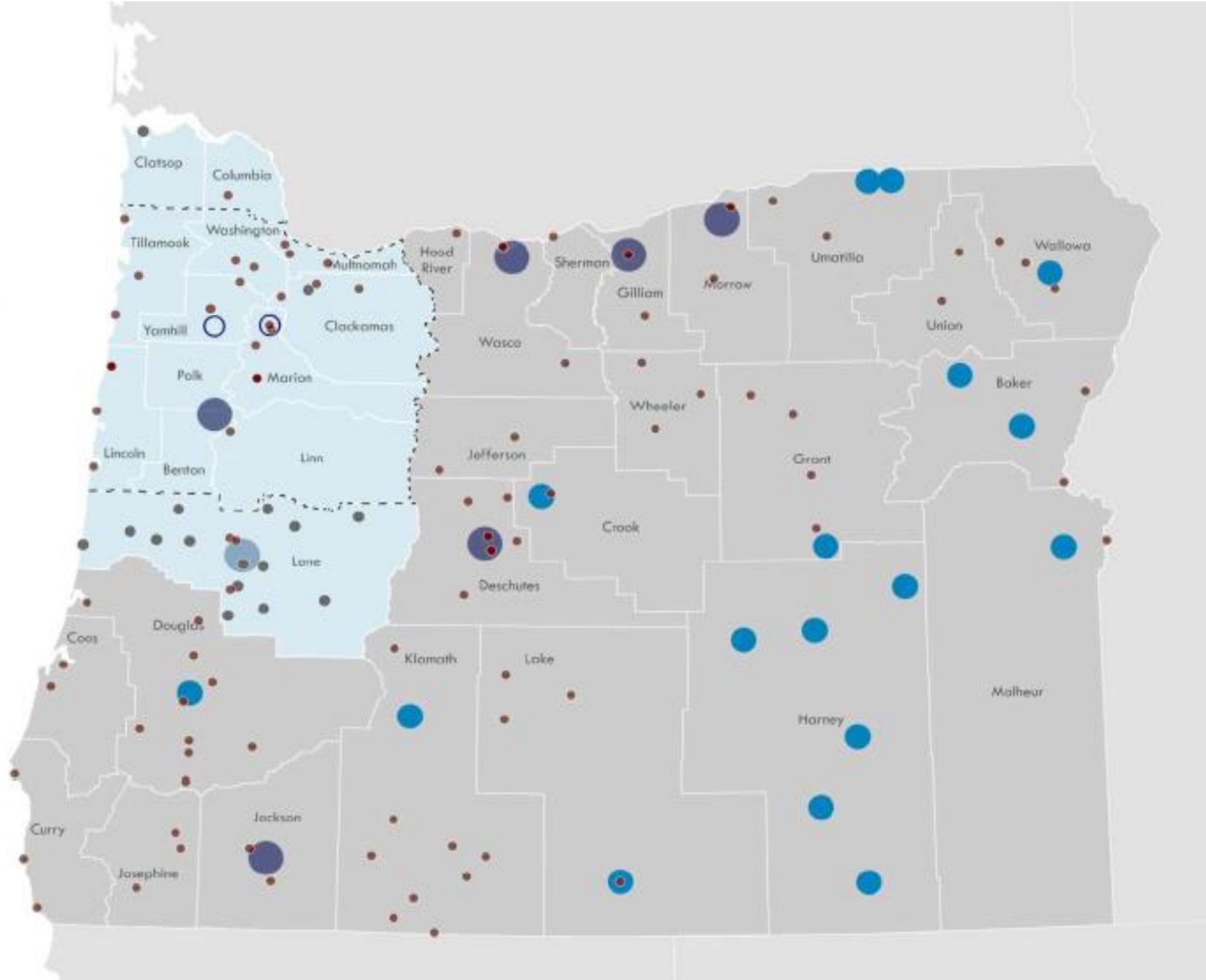
Coffin Butte Annual Tons (from all sources)



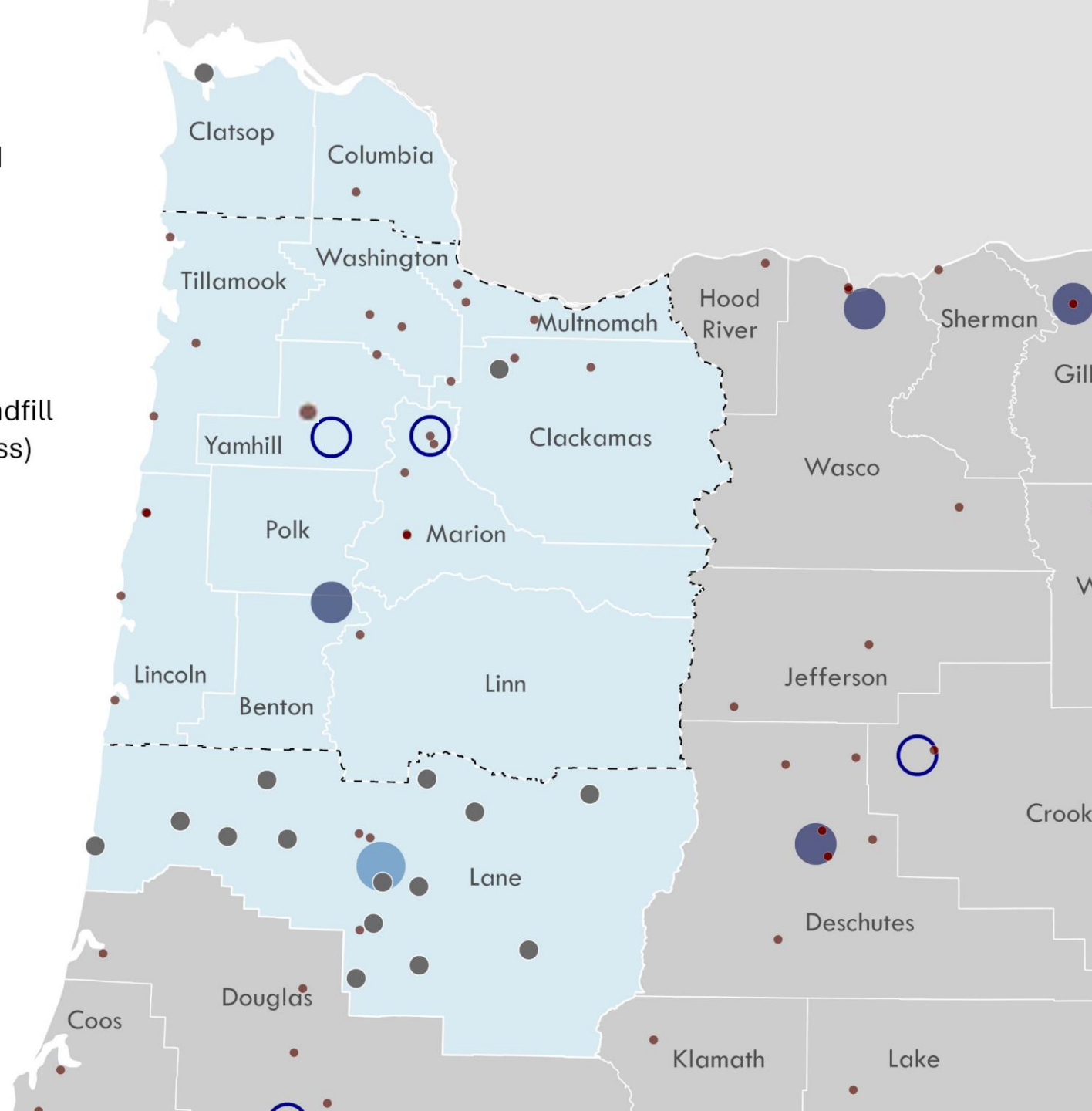
Riverbend Landfill began significantly lowering its waste intake in 2017, driven by nearing capacity and the defeat of the expansion.

Marion County began sending more waste to Coffin Butte.

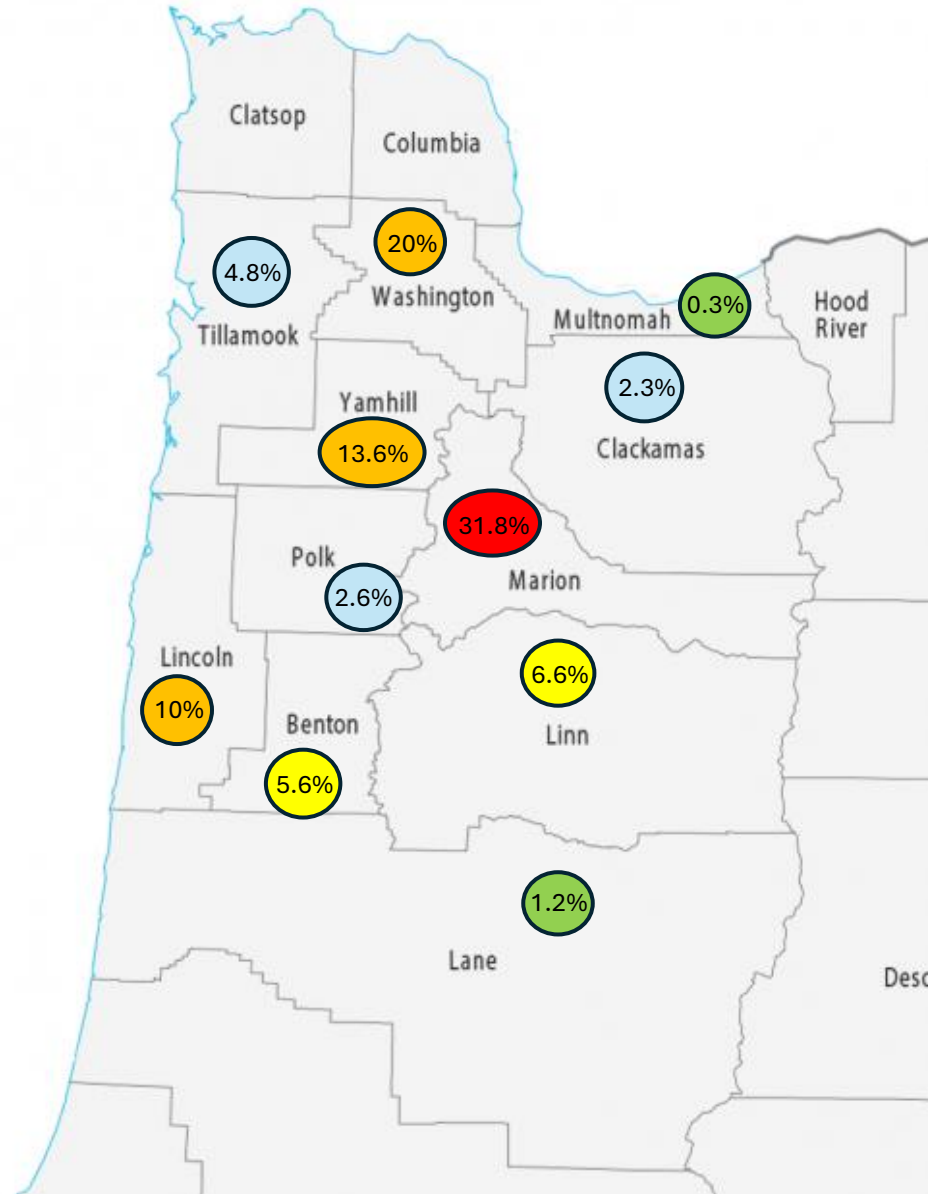
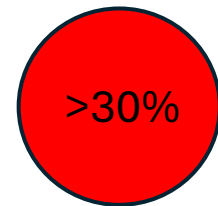
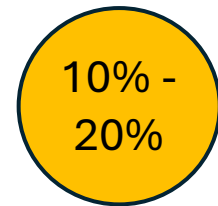
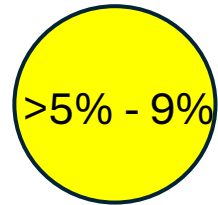
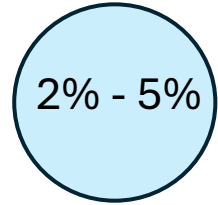
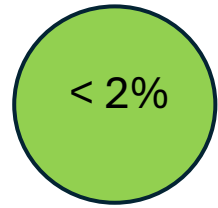
