Committee Appointees

Governor's appointees (7) must include at least one member representing each of:

- An Oregon institution of higher education;
- A statewide trade organization;
- Urban interests in this state; and
- Rural or agricultural interests in this state.

Legislators (2) are non-voting members.

A majority of members (5) constitutes **quorum**.

Official action by the committee requires the approval of a majority of the voting members (4) of the committee.



Committee Action and Activities

- **Meetings** are limited to one or two per calendar year.
- The committee may:
 - Organize activities for and host visiting delegations from Ireland;
 - Organize activities for and participate in delegations visiting Ireland;
 - Provide for the exchange of information between the State of Oregon and Ireland;
 - Work with representatives of Ireland on joint projects;
 - Take all actions necessary to coordinate and promote Oregon exports to Ireland and Irish investments within Oregon; and
 - Visit Ireland at least biennially for the purpose of fulfilling the above objectives.
