To the Senators and Representatives on the Joint Interim Committee on Transportation Funding:

In the last 10 years, ODOT's budget has nearly quadrupled. Simultaneously, mission drift has intensified as political and ideological motives have overtaken the foundational work of maintaining a functioning infrastructure.

Included in this massive budget increase is a salary increase for the Agency head from \$176k to \$288k. In those same 10 years, my wages—like so many Oregonians—have remained stagnant. Yet year after year, with increasing frequency, I find Oregon state government reaching for my wallet.

I'm frankly too exhausted at this point to be diplomatic: you are running a grift on Oregonians at multiple levels. You are taking money away from my family, my kids, with flowery language of inclusivity, and eco-consciousness. It's estimated that Oregon's contribution to global emissions is somewhere around .05% yet here you are trying to boil the ocean by layering on fee after fee, tax after tax in the name of climate resilience.
