NO NEW TRANSPORTATION TAXES
NO INCREASES IN EXISTING TRANSPORTATION TAXES

While some state governments are decreasing their taxes, Oregon continues to push forward with tax increases. These increases hurt the poor and disadvantaged the most but ultimately put a drag on the entire Oregon economy.
