Oregon in June 1845, the legislature took action by passing a resolution stating:
“This house has no right to levy a tax of any kind without the consent of the free
voters of this territory previously obtained.”

Oregon Constitution Article I, Bill of Rights
Article I, Section 32 of the Oregon Constitution (1859) explicitly states:
“No tax or duty shall be imposed without the consent of the people or their
representatives in the Legislative Assembly;
