I am writing to you because I am concerned about the Special Session that the Governor has called to address funding for ODOT.

Oregonians are in dire financial straits because of the high prices for basic necessities, such as gas, food, clothing, etc. We cannot afford to incur the cost-of-living increases that will come if the legislature passes the proposed increases to the state gas tax, registration and title fees, and introducing a new Road Usage Charge program.
