Work Session

- HB 3871 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Establishes the Animal Welfare Trust to provide grants to entities that provide veterinary support services related to animals in low-income households or underserved communities.
- HB 3910
Expands the justifications for a domestic water supply district to exercise the powers of a sanitary district.
- HB 2773 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs the State Department of Fish and Wildlife to establish a program to award grants for recreational fishing facilities within an urban growth boundary.

Public Hearing

- HB 3544
Directs the Water Resources Department to study rules related to water.
- HB 3343
Requires the State Department of Fish and Wildlife to study natural resources.
- HB 3484
Directs the Water Resources Department to study rules related to water.

Work Session

- HB 2557
Prohibits a person from raising octopus for the purpose of human consumption or participating in the sale or offer for sale of octopus that was raised for human consumption.
- HB 3135 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs the Oregon Department of Administrative Services to award grants to soil and water conservation districts that operate in certain counties.
