Work Session

HB 3342

Directs the Water Resources Department to study rules related to water.

- HB 3343
 - Requires the State Department of Fish and Wildlife to study natural resources.
- HB 3544
 - Directs the Water Resources Department to study rules related to water.
- HB 2801

Allows the Water Resources Department to approve leases or temporary transfers of certain water rights in the Upper Klamath Basin until a court issues a final water rights decree.

HB 2988 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Instructs the Water Resources Department to take certain actions related to aquifer recharge and aquifer storage and recovery.

HB 3484

Directs the Water Resources Department to study rules related to water.

HB 3596 **

Directs the State Department of Fish and Wildlife to study mule deer in the Steens Mountain herd range area.

HB 3800

Renames the "Greater Harney Valley Groundwater Area of Concern" the "Harney Basin Groundwater Management Area.

HB 3501

Prohibits the consideration of whether certain changes related to water rights would impair or be detrimental to the public interest.

HB 2803 **

Increases certain fees related to water.

2808 HB

Increases certain fees related to wells.

HB 2165 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the Water Resources Department for costs related to well construction and compliance.

HB 3106 **

******Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the Department of Environmental Quality for the Oregon Water Data Portal project.

HB 3116 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the Water Resources Department for place-based water planning.

HB 3364

Makes changes related to a water supply grant program.

HB 3525

Requires, for each dwelling unit rented by a landlord for which the source of drinking water is a well that is subject to regulation, that the landlord collect and test samples of drinking water from the dwelling unit for arsenic, E.

HB 3526

Establishes a cause of action for a buyer in a real estate transaction if the seller fails to provide the results of required well tests.

HB 3806

Authorizes the Water Resources Commission to approve a Deschutes River water bank pilot program.

Public Hearing

HB 3372

Directs the Water Resources Department to study exempt uses of water.
