HB 2052 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Judiciary

Creates a violation for failure to comply with compulsory school attendance requirements.

HB 2060

Directs the Department of Education to establish and maintain a registry for nonlicensed tutors.

HB 2453

Requires the Department of Education to study the adequacy of public education in this state.

HB 2530

Modifies school bus stop arm camera law.

HB 3059 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires the Department of Human Services and the Department of Education to jointly study the needs of youth who are in a residential facility and who attend a public school in this state.

HB 3169 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs the Oregon Health Authority to modify the amounts of grants for school-based health centers for inflation.

HB 3624 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs education service districts to reimburse parents and legal guardians for fees incurred by parents and legal guardians related to examinations administered to homeschooled children.

HB 3915 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs the State Department of Agriculture to develop and maintain a model list of low-impact pesticides for use with school integrated pest management plans.

HB 3949

Prescribes requirements related to contracts entered into between the State Board of Education and a publisher of textbooks and instructional materials.
