HB 2405 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the Department of Corrections for distribution to some department institutions in eastern Oregon for the purpose of providing educational programs to adults in custody.

HB 2649

Permits certain public universities in this state to increase tuition and fees without the approval of the Higher Education Coordinating Commission.

- HB 2686 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Provides funding to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission for purposes of providing a grant to an organization that manages a statewide strategy to re-enroll residents of this state into certain programs.
- 3006 ** HB

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the Department of Education for various purposes related to increasing the representation of marginalized populations in the education workforce in this state.

- HB 3008 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Appropriates moneys to fund child care workforce investments.
- HB 3011 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Establishes the Early Childhood Education Workforce Development Fund and appropriates moneys in the fund to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission to provide funding to community colleges and public universities in this state that offer early childhood education
- degrees and certificates.
- HB 3026

Requires the Higher Education Coordinating Commission to study higher education.

HB 3029 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Makes changes to workforce development statutes to improve alignment across workforce development programs and projects.

HB 3030 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Authorizes the Higher Education Coordinating Commission to award grants to culturally and linguistically diverse school administrator candidates to use at approved educator preparation programs.

HB 3552

Allows education service districts to establish regional career centers to provide career and technical education.

HB 3634 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Establishes the Water Workforce Program in the Higher Education Coordinating Commission to support workforce development initiatives within the water workforce.

HB 3669 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Expands the goals and purposes of the Prosperity 10,000 Program.

Note change: HB 3213 and HB 2458 have been removed from the agenda.
