Public Hearing

- HB 2746 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/3/2025 MEETING: Requires employers and employment agencies to include certain wage and benefit information in job postings for job, promotion and transfer opportunities.
- HB 3550
Exempts from certain laws governing certain employment conditions minor league baseball players who are subject to a collective bargaining agreement that provides for payment of wages and other working conditions.

Work Session

- HB 2728
Directs the Public Employees Retirement System to include information about the use of overtime hours in calculating the final average salary of a member of the system who is retiring.
- HB 2802
Requires an insurer to make a lump sum payment of a permanent partial disability award if the worker waives reconsideration of the notice of closure or the award has become final by operation of law.
- HB 2957
Prohibits employers from entering into agreements that shorten the statute of limitations with respect to violations over which the Bureau of Labor and Industries has enforcement authority.
- HB 3181 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Establishes the Task Force on Youth Apprenticeship.
- HB 3216 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Requires contractors and subcontractors that must report compliance with the prevailing wage laws to submit certified statements and reports showing compliance to the Bureau of Labor and
