SB315

> Directs the Department of Education to review and make recommendations related to the recording of student absences and how school districts respond to student absences.

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Appropriates moneys to the Department of Education for distribution as grants to address the causes of chronic absenteeism.

SB784

> Specifies that the statewide standards for dual credit programs include programs in agriculture, forestry and natural resources.

SB 785 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Establishes the Agriculture Education Scholarship Program to provide free tuition and fees for qualifying agriculture education students in exchange for the student's commitment to work in a rural community after graduation.

SB

Requires a public institution of higher education to award academic credit when an enrolled student completed a high school class or participated in a high school program that offered learning and experiences comparable to an introductory communications, public speaking or argumentation course offered at the institution.

#### **Work Session**

SB 1098

Prohibits discrimination when selecting or retaining school library materials, textbooks or instructional materials or when developing and implementing a curriculum.
