Possible Work Session

SB 92

Allows a community solar project with a nameplate capacity of five megawatts or less to participate in the community solar program.

SB 956

Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services to provide a grant to Heard Farms to expand wastewater treatment infrastructure.

SB 992

Requires the Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission to study the modernization of the beverage container redemption and recycling law.

SB 1143 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs the Public Utility Commission to establish a pilot program that allows each natural gas company to develop a utility-scale thermal energy network pilot project to provide heating and cooling services to customers.

Public Hearing

SB 1187

Establishes the Climate Superfund Cost Recovery Program as an interagency response to the effects of climate change.
