#### Work Session

SB 106

Requires the Legislative Revenue Officer to study the interdependence of the state and local tax systems in Oregon.

#### Public Hearing and Work Session

SB 1196

Requires the Legislative Revenue Officer to study means for raising dedicated revenue to support recreation activities in Oregon.

HB 2089 A

Provides for a process by which former owners of real property deeded to the county for delinquent property taxes may claim the surplus value after the property has been disposed of by the county.

HB 2351 B

Makes changes to certain statutes related to the release and reporting of businesses' economic development information.
