Work Session

SB 813

Adds employees of the Oregon Youth Authority or a county juvenile department to the list of people who are authorized to petition the circuit court for an order compelling a third party to complete a test for communicable diseases under certain circumstances.

SB 846

Modifies the requirements for how the Oregon Health Authority monitors the progress of coordinated care organizations in improving access to and the quality of health care for children and youth in the areas served by the coordinated care organizations.

Please note: SB 140 is scheduled solely for the purpose of hearing testimony from the people who previously signed up to testify at the meeting on 2/13/2025.

SB 140 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2/13/2025 MEETING: Requires the Oregon Health Authority and coordinated care organizations to increase reimbursement rates for inpatient psychiatric services provided by hospitals to medical assistance recipients.

SB 835

Directs the Oregon Health Authority, in collaboration with the Department of Human Services and the nine federally recognized Indian tribes in Oregon, to adopt rules governing the collection, storage and use of data on tribal affiliation.

SB 841

Authorizes the Oregon Health Authority to enter into an agreement with a federally recognized Indian tribe in Oregon or a tribal epidemiology center in Oregon to allow the tribe or center to accept reports of reportable diseases and investigate cases of reportable diseases.

SB 822 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Expands network adequacy requirements to health benefit plans offered to large employers and modifies requirements.
