CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/17/2025 MEETING: Reduces to 45 days the time under which a city or county must decide a land use application for single-family dwellings.

Work Session

SB 586

Reduces from 90 to 45 days the termination notice period that a landlord must give the tenant when selling the dwelling unit to buyers who intend to reside in the unit.

SB 1095

Authorizes cities and counties to impose a fee on noncommercial residences that are vacant for more than 180 consecutive or cumulative days in a calendar year.
